Shade of History

Busuanga was coined from the Calamianes word “**busuang**” which means “**burst**.” Legend has it that hundreds of years ago a raging storm once struck Busuanga Island, causing the Busuanga River to overflow and inundate the whole island. It is believed to have been formally founded as early as 1622 with the establishment of Spanish local government in the town’s oldest barrio, now known as Barangay Old Busuanga. Busuanga was later converted into a municipality in 1951, and has evolved into a first-class municipality composed of 14 barangays being dwelt by over 26,974 people.

Tara sa USU: Getting to Busuanga

BY AIR



Fly to Busuanga from Clark, Manila, or Cebu Airports to USU via the following airlines:

- Sunlight Air
- Cebu Pacific
- Philippine Airlines (PAL)
- Airswift (also offers flights from Coron to El Nido)

BY SEA



- 2Go Travel
- Atienza Shipping Lines – departs from Baseco Port, Tondo (approx. 18 hours travel time)
- M/S D' ASEAN Journey (JVS Journey Sea Transport Inc.) – from Baseco Port, Tondo (approx. 18 hours travel time)
- Alternative route: Manila → Batangas → Mindoro → Coron (combined land and sea travel)

BY LAND



Ride a public or rented van (45 mins) from Coron to Busuanga. To get around the town, hire a motorcycle or rent a tricycle.

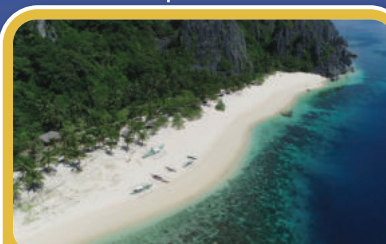
